A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF

RETIRING THE SERVICE WEAPON OF RETIRING CHIEF OF POLICE

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2019, Chief of Police Mark G. Pugliese I will be honorably retiring from West Hempfield Township and the West Hempfield Township Police Department after thirty-five years of service; and

WHEREAS, Mark G. Pugliese had been issued a service weapon by the Township for his use with the Police Department;

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Board of Supervisors of West Hempfield Township that the service weapon issued to Mark G. Pugliese I, a Glock Model 26, Gen 4, bearing the serial number BBTS904, is hereby retired and is to be transferred to Mark G. Pugliese I in accordance with applicable laws of this Nation and Commonwealth.
