RESOLUTION No. 09-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST HEMPFIELD TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR CONFLICTS-OF-INTEREST

WHEREAS, the Township often applies for grants and other funds from various organizations and agencies; and

WHEREAS, applications often ask if the applicant has a conflict-of-interest policy; and

WHEREAS, there are numerous laws and regulations in place which govern conflicts-of-interest which the Township must follow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of West Hempfield Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, that the following shall serve as West Hempfield Township's conflict-of-interest policy:

In accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, as well as specific agency regulations and requirements of specific funding allocations, West Hempfield Township does not permit conflicts-of-interest and requires decision makers and policy makers to abstain from discussions and actions, in accordance with these laws, requirements, and regulations, when they have a conflict-of-interest.

Section 2. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, section, sentences, clauses, or parts of this resolution, it being the intent of the Board of Supervisors that the remainder of the Resolution be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.
