



Notice of Opportunity to Comment - Bridge Replacement

Marietta Road (SR 0023) Bridge over Chickies Creek

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has joined with Plenary Walsh Keystone Partners (PWKP) on a Public-Private-Partnership (P3) to replace 558 deficient culverts and bridges across the state by 2018.

PennDOT and PWKP invite the public to submit comments on the following bridge construction:


Marietta Road (SR 0023) bridge over Chickies Creek.



Vehicular traffic would use a posted detour approximately 11.7 miles in length (Marietta Road PA 23, Prospect Road SR 4001, US 30, and River Road/Chickies Hill Road SR 0441).

A Public Plans Display is currently placed at the office of West Hempfield Township, 3401 Marietta Ave. Lancaster PA 17601 for the bridge listed above, tentatively scheduled for construction in June, 2016. The purpose of the display is to allow you to review the preliminary traffic control and engineering design plans for the replacement structure, and to allow you to provide input on any impact the work might have during and after construction.
